1. Introduction

The aim of this policy is to guide students in making a bursary application and to provide a clear framework for MLA College staff awarding bursaries.

MLA College believes that a lack of funds should not be a barrier to learning, and is committed to providing a number of bursaries each year to assist students in gaining access to its Higher Education programmes.

Bursaries will be made available for each of its intakes (September, January and May) each academic year. Bursaries are awarded at the discretion of MLA College and are not a student entitlement.

2. Available Bursaries (2022/23)

2.1 UK Bursary

6 x £500 bursaries for UK students over 25 years of age on enrolment.

Each bursary award will be for a value of £500, and will be made as a deduction from fees against the first module on which the applicant enrolls, following the production of the required evidence.

Eligibility to apply:

- Be enrolled/holding an unconditional offer on a MLA College Higher Education programme,
- Be paying the expected tuition fee in full,
- Be registered as a UK Student,
- Meet the appropriate income criteria (annual income of less than £25,000, normally confirmed by provision of evidence of 3 months' salary).

2.2 International Bursary

6 x £500 bursaries for non-UK students over 25 years of age on enrolment.

Each bursary award will be for a value of £500, and will be made as a deduction from fees against the first module on which the applicant enrolls, following the production of the required evidence.

Eligibility to apply:

- Be enrolled/holding an unconditional offer on a MLA College Higher Education programme,
- Be paying the expected tuition fee in full,
- Be registered as a non-UK Student.
- Meet the appropriate income criteria (annual income of less than £25,000, normally confirmed by provision of evidence of 3 months' salary).

2.3 Women in Maritime/STEM

6 x £500 bursaries for women over 25 years of age on enrolment, for UK and non-UK students.

Each bursary award will be for a value of £500, and will be made as a deduction from fees against the first module on which the applicant enrolls, following the production of the required evidence.

Eligibility to apply:

- Be enrolled/holding an unconditional offer on a MLA College Higher Education programme on a part time basis,
- Be paying the expected tuition fee as agreed with MLA College during the offer Process

3. Application Process

The number of bursaries is limited and will be awarded on a first come first served basis.

3.1 Bursary Application Form

Students are required to complete the Student Bursaries application form found at Annex A. The application form will also be available to download from the MLA College website.

Applicants must provide evidence of income (where required). Incomplete applications, or applications which don't include required evidence, will not be considered.

3.2 Bursary Application Timelines

The opening date for bursary applications is 2nd May 2022. Bursary application deadlines are:

- 1st August 2022 for September 2022 starters.
- 5th December 2022 for January 2023 starters.
- 3rd April 2023 for May 2023 starters.

4. Payment

Each bursary award will be made as a deduction from fees against the first module on which the applicant enrolls, following the production of the required evidence.
